Operation

- 1. Connect Bluetooth Adapter to 30-Pin connector of audio player.
- 2. Wait for Blue LED on Bluetooth Adapter to start flashing.
- 3. Make sure Bluetooth is enabled on audio host device and is within a 10 metre range.
- 4. Select <u>I-WAVE</u> in Bluetooth devices list to pair.
- 5. Enter PIN 0000 (if required).
- 6. After successful pairing, the LED on adapter stops flashing and remains Blue.
- 7. The audio host device is now ready to stream audio.

Compatibility

The Audio Adapter supports most audio dock / sound system / car audio player models with Apple 30-Pin connector (for audio signal input).

Troubleshooting

Issue	Cause
I can't hear audio	Check volume level on both the audio host device (e.g. your paired phone) and the 30-Pin audio player.
I still can't hear any audio	Locate the make/model of the 30-Pin audio player and then check with the manufacturer if the 30-Pin connector supports use with Bluetooth Audio Receivers.

IMPORTANT!

Please check 30-Pin connector on audio player supports use with 3rd party Bluetooth Audio Adapters.

The 30-Pin audio player MUST connect to an internal DAC hardware chipset (digital-to-analogue converter) for successful audio signal pass-through transmission.
